Current Counterterrorism Challenges

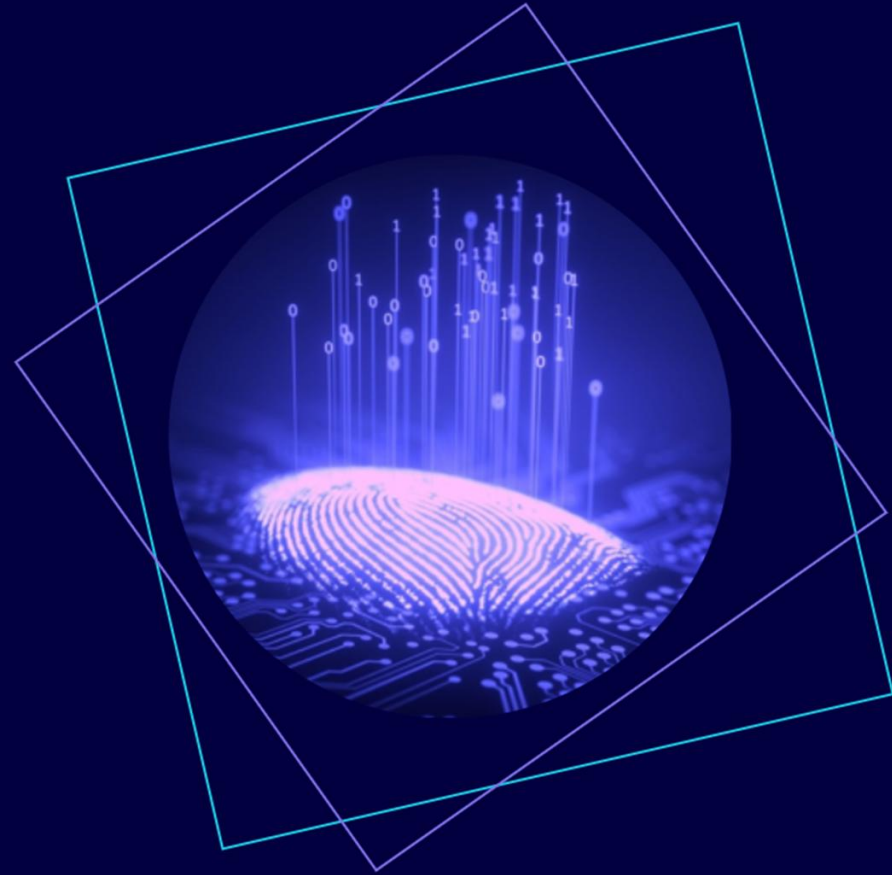
Online extremism and radicalization

Intelligence professionals are vital in gathering and analyzing information that supports law enforcement efforts in tracking and preventing potential attacks.

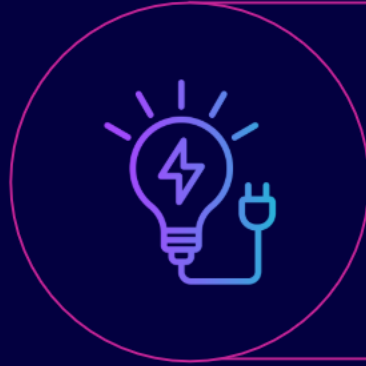
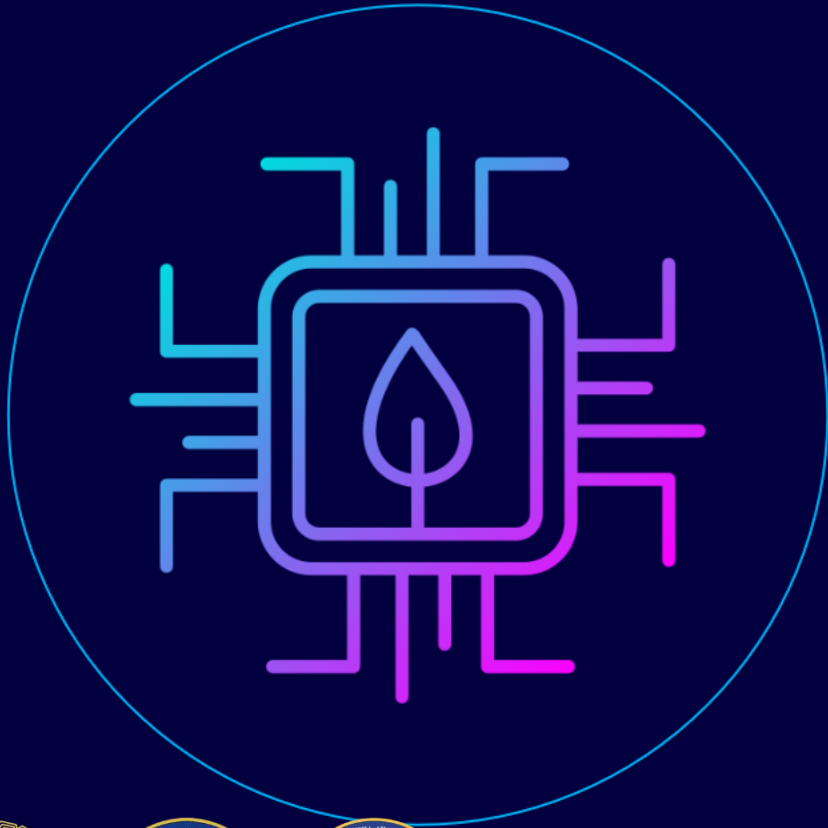
Law Enforcement Coordination at National and Local Levels

Military personnel undergo rigorous training to respond to terrorist threats effectively, enhancing operational readiness in various scenarios.

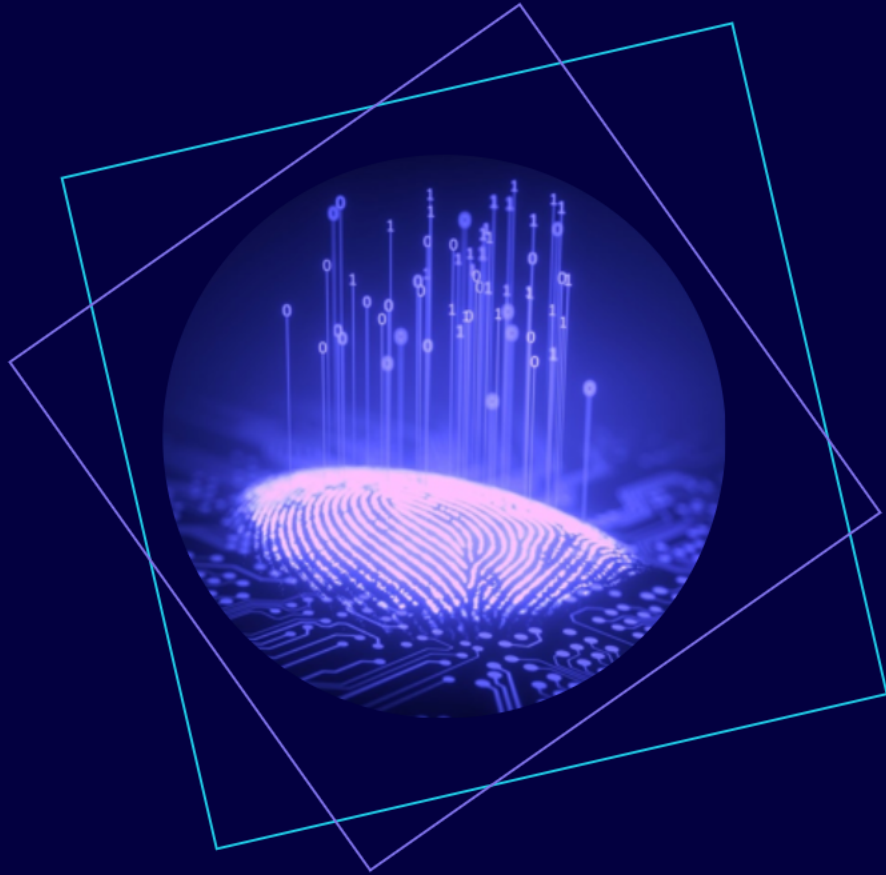


Strategic Partnerships with International Forces

Experts are creating robust cybersecurity frameworks to safeguard government and public sector systems against potential cyberterrorism threats.

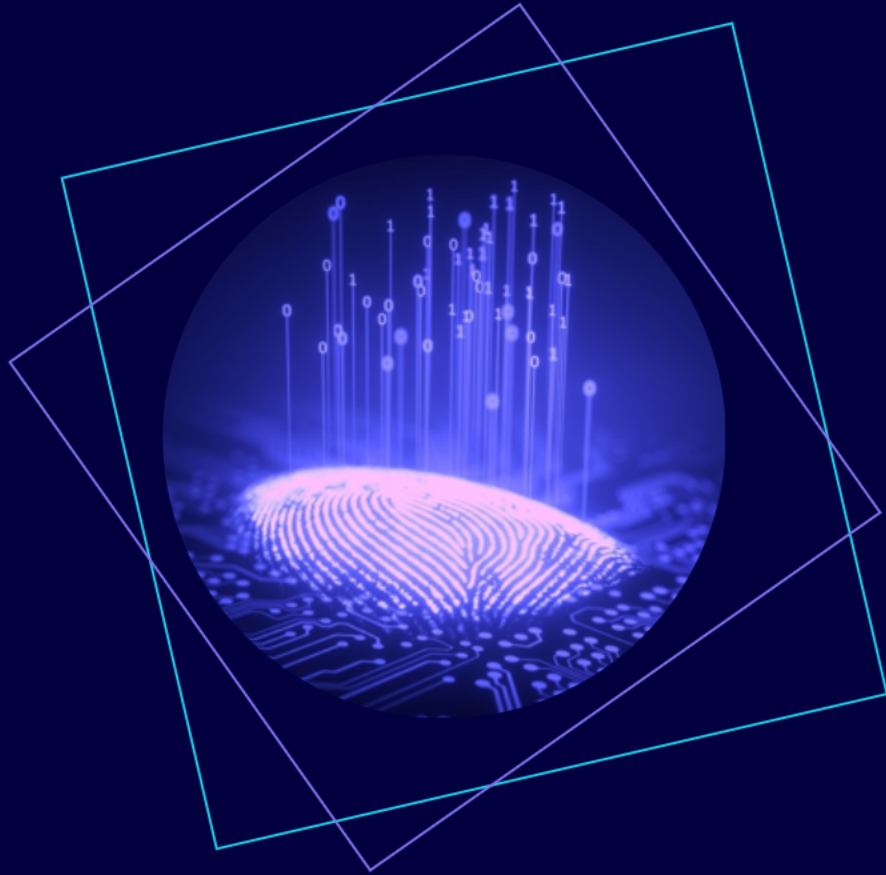


Machine learning algorithms for threat analysis

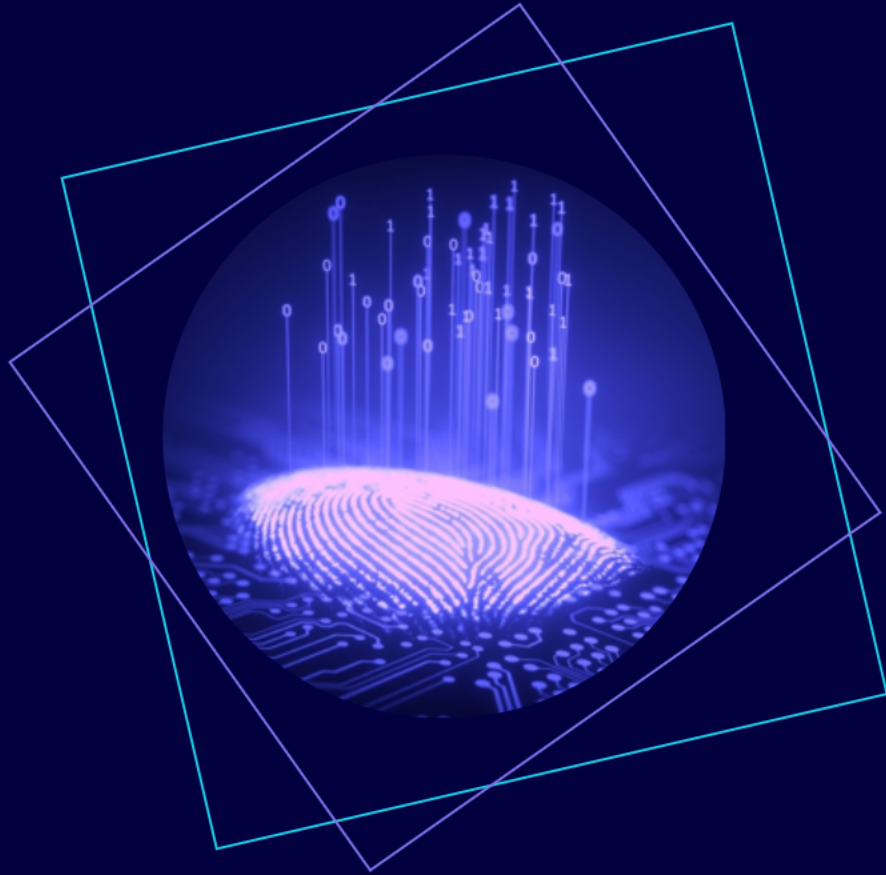

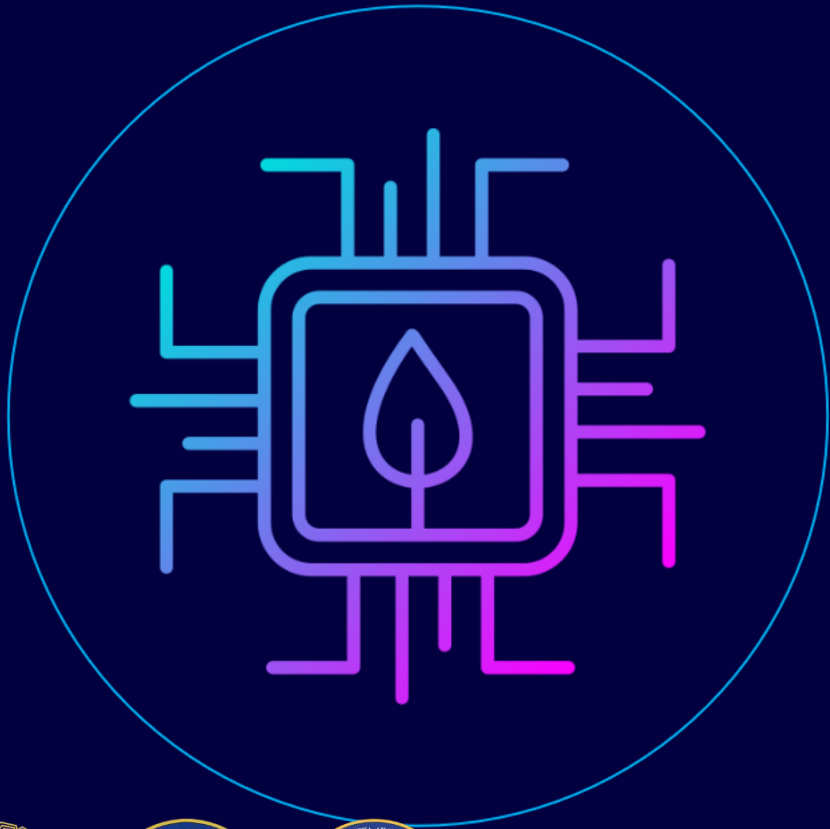
